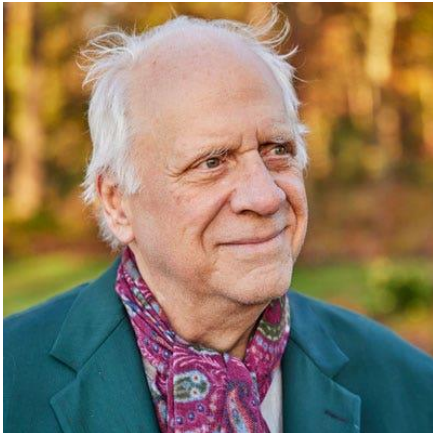


**Luncheon with George Ball,

The Burpee Company, founded in Philadelphia in 1876 by W. Atlee Burpee, has a long history of innovation in vegetable, fruit, and flower seeds and related products for America’s gardens. Since 1991, the company has been owned and led by George Ball, currently Chairman of the Board, and the innovative tradition has continued. Nearby historic Fordhook Farm remains the research farm where the company breeds and trials its plants. Mr. Ball’s additional achievements include vegetable seed relief programs, leadership positions at educational institutions, and numerous philanthropic programs.
